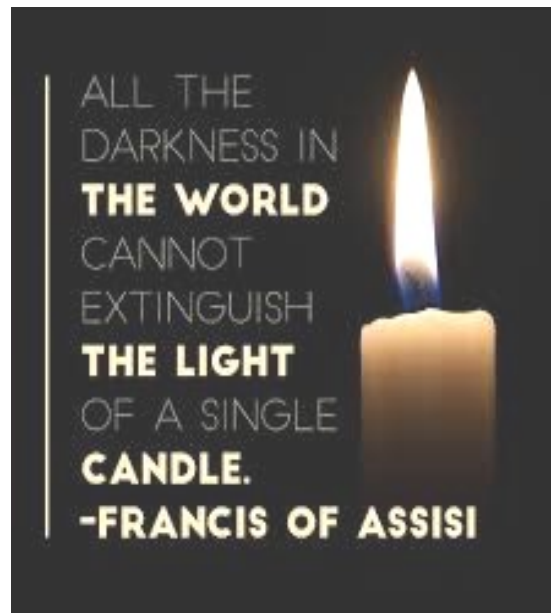
Epistle: Philippians 2:12-30
