Gospel: Mark 4:1-34

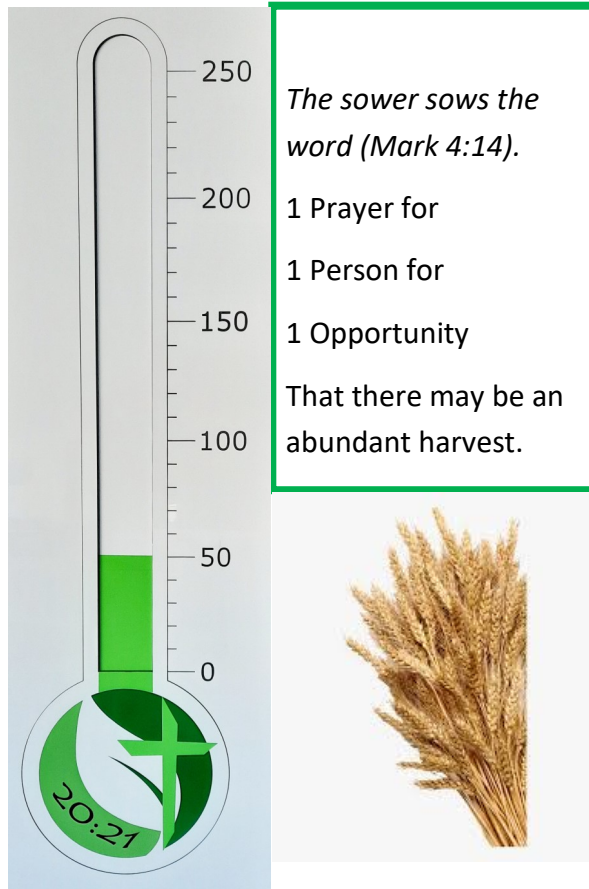
SENTENCE:
