

Questions for 25 July 2021

1. What stories from the Old Testament do you remember best? How did you come to know these stories? As an adult, how has your understanding of these stories changed?
2. How often do you read from: the Psalms, the other books of the Old Testament, the Gospels, and the Epistles and the Book of Revelation?
3. Which of those sections in Question 2 do you find of most value, and why? With which do you struggle, and why?
4. Often, stories from the Bible are used to illustrate a point. Why might this do a disservice to the biblical account?
5. What bearing does the account of Israel's history in the Old Testament have on the church?
6. In what way is the Bible an authority for you and your life?
7. In an age where people value only what is new and innovative, what value does the history of the church have for you? What value does the history of Anglicanism have?
