

Questions on Ephesians 4:1-16

Read Ephesians 4:1-16

1. What phrases would you regard as being “a view from the summit”?
2. Of the four qualities of a life lived “in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called”, rate yourself on a scale of 1 to 10 as to how well that quality describes you. Share with the group your best and worst qualities (if you wish).
3. What effort have you made recently “to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace”?
4. Of the seven aspects of unity listed in verses 4 to 6, which do you find the most significant, and why?
5. Verse 7 tells us that each person has been gifted in some way. Do you know what your gift(s) may be?
6. Verse 11 lists 4 (maybe 5) gifts Christ has given to the church. Discuss what each may be.
7. What is the purpose of these gifts (verse 12)?
8. What is the goal of these gifts (verse 13)?
9. What are the characteristics of being a child (immature) in verse 14, and how might these be seen in the church today/
10. Have you ever been “spoken the truth to in love”? Why might this action be limited to the four (five) “word ministries” in verse 11?
11. Discuss the significance of verse 16.
